South Fayette Township Hunting/Fishing Rules and Regulations

1. All laws set by the Pennsylvania Game Commission and the Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission apply.
2. The township reserves the right to designate hunting zones.
3. The township reserves the right to regulate the number of permit holders.
4. Single-projectile shotguns are permitted and may be used in designated areas.
5. Muzzle-loaders may be used in designated areas.
6. Archery may be used in designated areas.
7. There is a **150-yard safety zone around all playgrounds, athletic fields, and buildings.**
8. No driving on fields or tractor lanes.
9. Parking is allowed in designated areas only.
10. No building of open fires.
11. No hunting on Sunday or after sunset.
12. Permits are valid for the same time period as the hunting license, not to exceed one year.
13. Permits may be revoked for any violation.
14. Permit must be carried at all times when hunting on township property.
15. ***No hunting allowed the third weekend of October.***

I also understand that any deviation from or violation of the South Fayette Township Hunting/Fishing Rules and Regulations, the Pennsylvania Game Law, or the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Regulations shall not be tolerated and may result in citations or be considered for permanent expulsion from hunting on South Fayette Township property.
