RESOLUTION NO. 15 OF 2019

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE
GRANTING OF VOLUNTEER FIRE TAX CREDITS**

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2018, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette, by Ordinance No. 2 of 2018, established a Volunteer Service Credit program for volunteer members of the South Fayette Volunteer Fire Company that provides certain earned income tax and real estate tax credits to eligible volunteers; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 5 of 2018, the Township of South Fayette has established certain criteria in order to obtain the Volunteer Service Credit in accordance with Ordinance No. 2 of 2018; and

WHEREAS, the South Fayette Township Volunteer Fire Departments have certified that the Volunteer Firemen identified on Exhibit "A" have met the qualifications to be eligible for the Volunteer Service Credit in accordance with Resolution 5 of 2018 and Ordinance No. 2 of 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Township Manager has reviewed the certification provided and believes that the individuals have met the eligibility criteria to receive the Volunteer Service Credits.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, and it is HEREBY RESOLVED and

ENACTED as follows:

1. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated herein by reference thereto.
2. The Board approves the granting of a Volunteer Fire Service Credits to the volunteers identified on Exhibit "A" for earned income taxes and/or real estate taxes in such amounts as further identified on Exhibit "A".
3. This Resolution is to take effect upon adoption;
4. Any Ordinance or Resolution, or portion thereof, conflicting with the provisions of this Resolution shall be and the same is hereby repealed, insofar as the same affects this Resolution.
