ORDINANCE NO. 02 OF 2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 43, MANAGER, OF THE SOUTH FAYETTE CODE, BY REINSTATEMENT OF SECTION 43-6 TITLED “BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH APPOINTMENTS OR REMOVALS”.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette by Ordinance No. 8 of 2020, repealed Chapter 43 Manager, §43-6, “Board of Commissioners Not to Interfere with Appointments or Removals”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have determined that the reinstatement of Chapter 43 Manager, Section 43-6, “Board of Commissioners Not to Interfere with Appointments or Removals”, is appropriate to ensure the autonomy of the office of the Manager.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated herein by reference thereto.
2. Chapter 43 Manager, Section 43-6 is hereby reinstated and is set forth as follows:

§ 43-6 Board of Commissioners Not to Interfere with Appointments or Removals.

Neither the Board of Commissioners nor any of its members shall direct or request the appointment of any person to, or removal from, office by the Township Manager or any of the Manager’s subordinates, or in any manner take part in the appointment or removal of officers and employees in the administrative services of

the Township. Except for the purpose of inquiry, the Board of Commissioners and its members shall deal with the administration solely through the Township Manager and neither the Board of Commissioners nor any member thereof shall give orders to any subordinates of the township manager, either publicly or privately.


3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeals shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other aspects, this ordinance shall be cumulative of the other ordinance regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.

4. If any section or provision or parts hereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any other section or provision or part thereof.

5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
